QUESTIONS FOR STUDENT AND PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. Yes / No. Are you willing to maintain and wear the Army JROTC uniform one day per week, and if absent, wear the uniform on the next day present for school? If you fail to wear the uniform the first day 10 points will be deducted, if you fail to wear the uniform the second day 20 points will be deducted, the third day 30 points will be deducted, if the uniform is not work it is up to derision of the teacher to give you any way from 0-55 points. All uniforms will be provided by the JROTC program free of charge with in one week of receipt of application to join. Uniform includes but not limited to Class "A's", ACU's, Black or Gray Tee shirt and Physical Fitness Training uniform. Upon return of uniform it must be cleaned with attached dry cleaners' ticket.

2. Yes / No. Are you willing to participate in physical activities to include events such as: push-ups, sit-ups, chin-ups, pull-ups, partial curl-ups, flexed-arm hang, right angle push-ups, V-sit reach, sit and reach, shuttle run and the 2 mile run/walk?

Yes / No. (Males) On uniform day are you willing to adhere to U.S. Army Cadet Command Regulations governing proper grooming standards which include: neatly groomed haircuts (not touching the ears or collar), no earrings, cornrows/braids or other similar hairstyles? **Failure to comply with this policy may result in disenrollment from the JROTC program.**

Yes / No. (Females) On uniform day are you willing to adhere to U.S. Army Cadet Command Regulations governing proper grooming standards which include hair of natural color, worn up off the shirt collar and not covering the eyes; one set of stud or ball type earrings and no excessive jewelry? **Failure to comply with this policy may result in disenrollment from the JROTC program.**
